A PANDEMIC YEAR

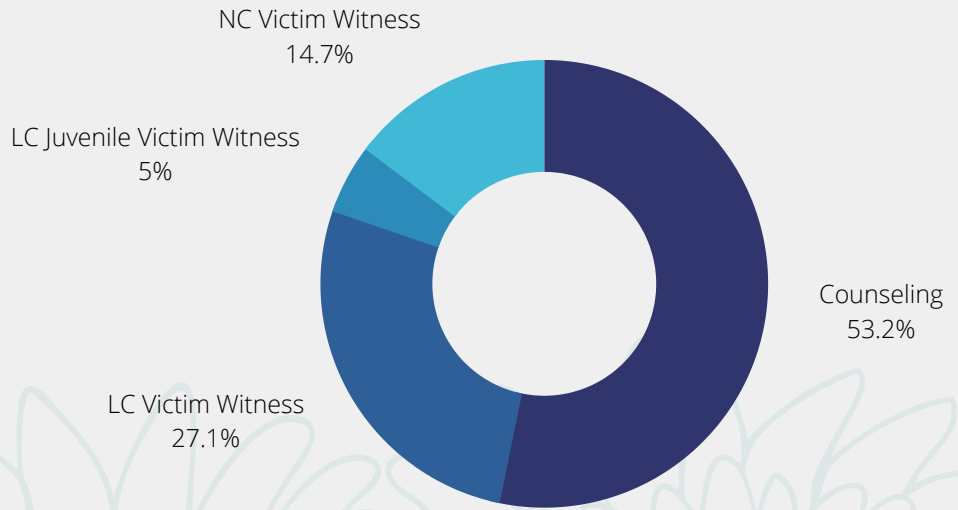
Throughout the COVID-19 pandemic, our mission and work did not change. Yes, the way we were doing our work changed to accommodate the situation, but we continued to provide an essential service to victims of crime. We continued to provide counseling via telehealth platforms that provide a “face to face” experience while reducing in-person exposure. We continued to provide in-person court accompaniment as court procedures took place in person and phone or internet support at other times. Our prevention education and outreach specialists creatively provided educational programming via internet and social media platforms. We continued to provide hospital accompaniment to victims of sexual assault either in person or remotely. And, of course, our 24-hour hotline continued to be available for anyone to call at any time.

Yes, during a difficult time, CVC continued to work hard and move forward. During the pandemic we hired a Bilingual Spanish counselor and are thrilled to have her on our staff. We also moved our main office to a new location at 12th and Downyflake Rds. This move increased accessibility and parking for our staff and clients. We are grateful for all that has been accomplished this past year.

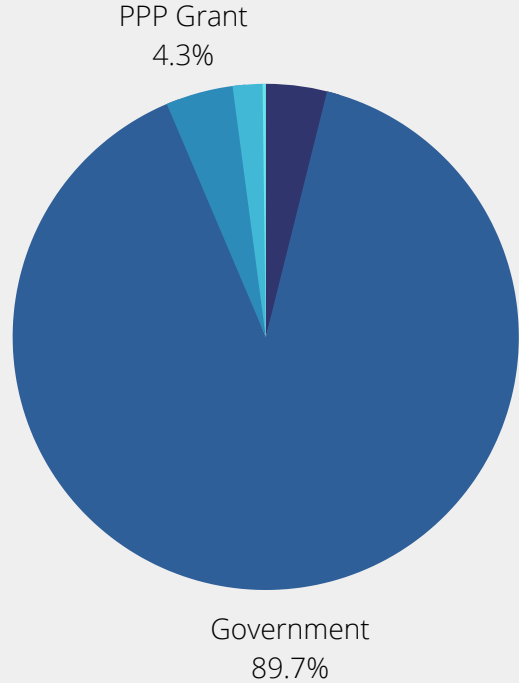
Community Outreach

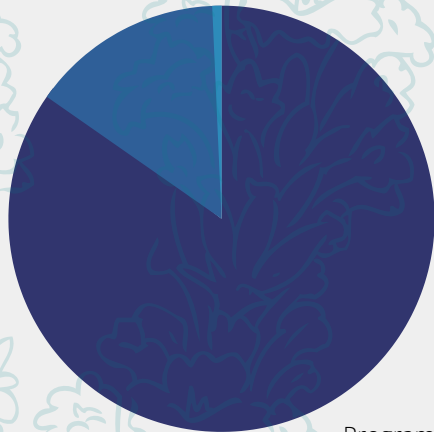
